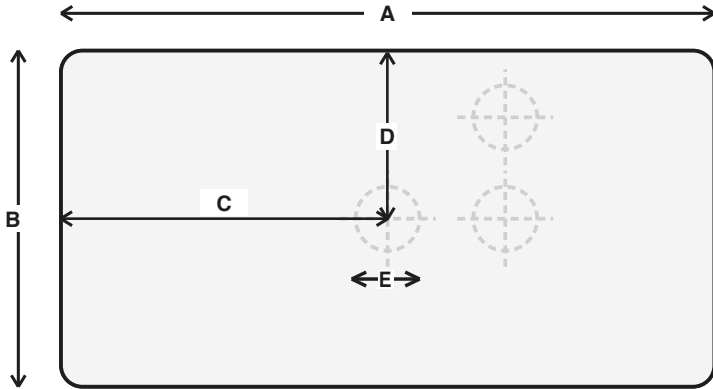

1. MEASURE THE FLAT BOTTOM SURFACE & MARK THE DRAIN LOCATION

Measure the flat bottom surface where the grid will actually sit - not the top opening or rounded sink walls. Use the nearest 1/8 inch. Below are the 3 most common drain layouts. Circle or check the one that best matches your sink, then write in the requested measurements. If needed, draw directly on the form.



Use this area to mark your actual drain location if helpful.

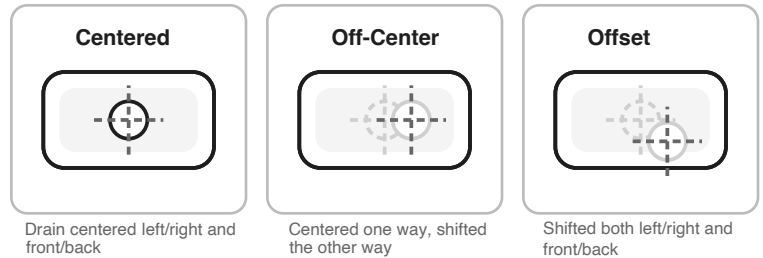
Main sink bottom area

Centered drains: typically only the overall bottom length and width are needed.

Off-center or offset drains: please provide the left-to-center, and front-to-center drain measurements.

Standard Drains have a 4-1/2" flange overall with a 3-1/2" drain opening, and the grid drain hole we standardize is 5" for easy access

Choose the finish and the feet / bumper guard options below. Black feet and bumper guards are our default unless another color is selected.
